### **1. Givers give – Philippians 4:14-18**

- One of the greatest givers I have known was my mom.
- Givers give willingly out of a heart of love. John 3:16
- Givers express gratitude. “I thank my God every time I remember you...” Phil. 1:3-5,7
- Givers give to meet needs. “You shared in my troubles...when I was in need.” Phil. 4:14,16
- I am blown away by Paul's words in Phil. 4:18. Paul had learned the secret of joy, peace and contentment.
- Givers give to please God. Phil. 4:18
- Givers receive God's promise. Phil. 4:19 Think of Elisha in 2 Kings 4:1-7.
- The truth is that you can never out give God!

### **2. Why do we have needs? Philippians 4:19 “And my God will meet all your needs according to his glorious riches in Christ Jesus.”**

- To teach us that God is our provider, Jehovah Jireh. Genesis 22:14 “And My God will meet all your needs...” Do you believe that?
- To teach us to trust God and walk by faith. Hebrews 11:1,6
- To teach us to walk by faith daily. “Our daily bread.”
