1. <u>Givers give</u> – Philippians 4:14-18

- One of the greatest givers I have known was my mom.
- <u>Givers give willingly out of a heart of love</u>. John 3:16
- <u>Givers express gratitude</u>. "I thank my God every time I remember you..." Phil. 1:3-5,7
- <u>Givers give to meet needs</u>. "You shared in my troubles...when I was in need." Phil. 4:14,16
- I am blown away by Paul's words in Phil. 4:18. Paul had learned the secret of joy, peace and contentment.
- <u>Givers give to please God</u>. Phil. 4:18
- <u>Givers receive God's promise</u>. Phil. 4:19 Think of Elisha in 2 Kings 4:1-7.
- The truth is that you can never out give God!

2. <u>Why do we have needs?</u> Philippians 4:19 "And my God will meet all your needs according to his glorious riches in Christ Jesus."

- <u>To teach us that God is our provider</u>, Jehovah Jireh. Genesis 22:14 "And My God will meet all your needs..." Do you believe that?
- <u>To teach us to trust God</u> and walk by faith. Hebrews 11:1,6
- <u>To teach us to walk by faith daily</u>. "Our daily bread."
