DON'T STOP PRAYING

November 8, 2020 Matthew 7:7-12

Are you discouraged because it seems like God is not answering your prayers? Pray anyway. Don't stop praying. What fuels our prayers is faith. No matter what happens, will you trust God? If so you will...

1. KEEP ON ASKING

- These commands are in the present tense imperative and stress continued, persistent action. You pray until God gives you an answer. Ask.
- "Then Jesus told his disciples a parable to show them that they should always pray and not give up (Luke 18:1)."
- When you ask expect God to answer. "Keep on believing, God will answer prayer." God answers every prayer: Yes, No, or Wait. I John 5:14-15.
- Jesus illustrated asking in Matthew 7:9-11. We pray for our daily bread.

2. KEEP ON SEEKING

- Seeking comes with increased intensity. We seek when something is lost.
- "But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well (Matthew 6:33)."
- Jesus said to Mary after the resurrection, "Woman, why are you crying? Who is it you are looking for (John 20:15)."
- Do you believe that seekers become finders? Psalm 34:10

3. KEEP ON KNOCKING

- "Knock and the door will be opened to you (7:7-8)."
- Are you facing a closed door?
- An open door can mean a door of opportunity.
- Keep knocking and then look for God to open the right door for you.
- All these commands are given as you seek to love your neighbor.
