April 4, 2021 Matthew 28:1-10 & the Hymn "He Lives"

"Can you imagine what the disciples...of Jesus must have said as word spread that he was not in the tomb?...'He lives'...(Diana Matthews)."

1. The evidence of Scripture – Matthew 28:1-10

- Two Mary's went to the tomb of Jesus to pay their last respects. 28:1
- What happened before they got there? 28:2 An earthquake caused by an angel had rolled back the stone. To let Jesus out? The story of the guards.
- "Do not be afraid, for I know that you are looking for Jesus...He is not here; he has risen, just as he said. Come and see..." Check it out. 28:5-6
- "Go quickly and tell his disciples: 'He has risen from the dead...'" 28:7
- "Suddenly Jesus met them..." 28:9

2. The testimony in the song "He Lives" by Pastor Alfred Ackley

- Alfred Ackley wrote "He lives" in 1932 after hearing a liberal preacher say on the radio on Easter Sunday morning...
- "I serve a risen Savior...I see His hand of mercy, I hear His voice of cheer and
 just the time I need Him he's always near." vs. 1
- "In all the world around me I see His loving care...I know that he is leading through all the story blast..." vs. 2 It was the time of the Great Depression.

3. What about your testimony & response to the resurrection of Jesus?

- Does Jesus "walk with you and talk to you"? That's relationship.
- How do you see Jesus helping you when things are tough? How does He give you hope and encouragement? That's relationship.
